A lot of things have changed since Windows 7, especially how to get around inside the system. The all new interface will prove to be frustrating until you get used to it. The short introduction is designed to cover the installation requirements, some of the new features, and the most common way to navigate the system. We have also provided a short 20 question pop quiz on the Windows 8 as well as a Shortcut Worksheet of the most common shortcut keys required to navigate the system.

I would advise putting your students on it as soon as possible or make it a project for over the summer break.
